



The Slippery Rock Community Library began as a stop on the book mobile route. In 2005, it officially became the Slippery Rock Community Library, located in a small room at the Slippery Rock Community Park. It was soon evident that the library needed more space, and through fundraising efforts, it moved into its current location in the fall of 2018.

The SRCL is a part of the Butler County Federated Library System, serving residents of the Slippery Rock and Harrisville areas. Membership is open to members of all communities, and as library resources across the world have seen a decline, the SRCL has seen an increase in memberships from communities across the area.

While the library enjoys the benefits of a small amount of local government funding, SRCL does not receive state-funding, and as such relies heavily on donations and individual contributions.

The Slippery Rock Community Library Friends play an important role in assisting with fundraising efforts to ensure that the library meets its main objective of providing exceptional services to its patrons.
